Open the cover and gently vacuum interior of alarm. Keep vacuum nozzle from touching the unit. Do not paint the smoke alarm. Test Monthly - test the unit monthly by pressing the test button. Problems may be indicated if the alarm does not sound upon pressing the test button/cover. The alarm
