## PROPERTY TAX



**Property Taxes are due twice per year.**

**INTERIM Taxes due: March 11<sup>th</sup> 2026 and FINAL Taxes due: September 16<sup>th</sup> 2026**

There are several ways you can pay your property taxes:

- 1) By Mail: Cheques made out to 'The Township of Hudson' (may be post-dated).
- 2) Cash or Cheque, in-person at the municipal office.
- 3) Through online banking using EFT (use your 19-digit roll # as the account number).
- 4) Secure drop box located at the municipal office building.

**\*PLEASE NOTE: An administrative fee of \$5 is charged for all tax bill reprints.**

# RECREATION & COMMUNITY HALL



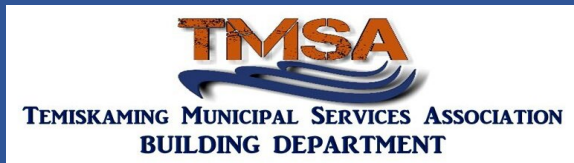

## BUILDING PERMITS

Building Permits must be obtained before beginning any construction project. Building Permits are for the safety of the home owner and any future owners of the property and provide information to MPAC in order to keep property assessments current.

Building Permit Applications can be obtained on the municipal website (fillable PDF) or at the municipal office.



## LIBRARY NEWS:

Hudson Outreach Library will be **closed as of June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2026**. Future updates will be posted on the municipal website.

Residents are welcome to use the Armstrong Township Library in Earleton located at 32 Tenth St East FREE of charge.

Residents can also use the City of Temiskaming Shores Library. A yearly paid membership fee is required, but receipts can be submitted to the municipal office for a partial refund. Contact the municipal office for further details.

## HALF LOAD RESTRICTIONS

During the spring thaw, roads are weakened by thawing and moisture. During this time, and in order to protect road infrastructure, the Township of Hudson places "Half load" restrictions on all municipal roads. "Half load" restrictions are seasonal weight limits and mean that vehicles exceeding 5 tonnes per axle are prohibited on designated roads. Should this situation effect you, please contact the municipal office to confirm when these restrictions are in place.

All open-air burning and incinerators require a Fire Permit between April 1<sup>st</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup>.

Small (1m<sup>2</sup>) contained campfires do **NOT** require a fire permit.

Permit applications can be downloaded from the municipal website (PDF version) or picked up at the Township office. Please allow sufficient time for review and issuance of fire permits.

Reminder: NO fires are to be lit before 6pm. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to check the status of burn restrictions throughout the seasons.
